












Exclusive Breast Feeding Duration







Supplementary Food with Breast Milk




Child Feeding Knowledge




Facility Utilization During Illness




Facility Preference During Delivery




Find Difficulty in Utilizing Govt Health Facility



What type of Difficulty in Utilizing Govt Health Facility








Hand wash with soap is Important






Nurse/Doctor visit in Past Three Month



Health Awareness Camp in Past Six Month




Anganwadi worker visit in past one Month






Migration from One Place to Other


